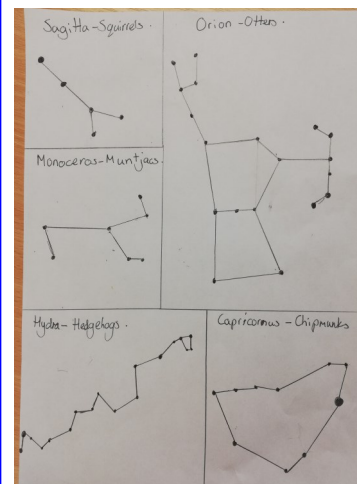

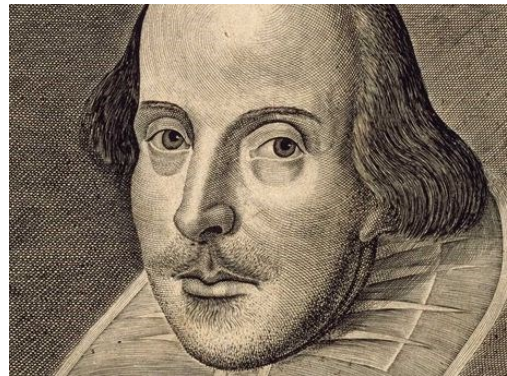
Otter Class' William Shakespeare art inspired by Koriky Paul.
